**September 14<sup>th</sup>, 2018- Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross- Family Retreat** To start off the Sunday School year, we will have a mini-retreat for all families in our parish. The theme is "On the Holy Cross", which is to understand why the Cross is such an important part of our Christian life. Here is the schedule:

- 6:30 PM to 7:00 PM- "Why is Jesus's sacrifice important?"
- 7:00 PM to 7:15 PM Arts and Crafts
- 7:15 PM- Preparation for the prayers
- 7:30 PM- Great Vespers and Divine Liturgy for the Exaltation of the Cross. Celebrant Fr. Fouad. Homily by Fr. Musil: "How can we use our cross to glorify God?"
- 9:00 PM. Dinner and Potluck with Bonfire

**September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2018-** First Day of Sunday School at 10:30 AM in the Rectory. We will have a welcome **breakfast for the parents and kids**. This will give you a chance to **meet our teachers**.

November 18<sup>th</sup>, 2018- One combined Divine Liturgy at 11:30 AM. Annual Thanksgiving Potluck. We ask that parents and parishioners sign up to donate a Thanksgiving food item for the parish luncheon.

November 25<sup>th</sup>, 2018- Celebration of the Feast of the Presentation of the Theotokos in the Temple- Girls will wear White top with a black Bottom, and join in the procession and explain the story of the feast to the parishioners.
