AT THE DIVINE LITURGY

Troparion of the Resurrection (3rd Tone): Let all in heaven rejoice and all on earth be glade, for the Lord has exerted power with His arm: by death He has trampled upon Death and has become the firstborn of the dead. He has delivered us from the bosom of Hades and has granted to the world great mercy.

Brethren, it was fitting that we should have such a high priest, holy, innocent, undefiled (Cf. Lv. 16: 6), set apart from sinners, and become higher than the heavens. He does not need to offer sacrifices daily (as the other priests did), first for his own sins, and then for the sins of the people; for this latter he did once for all in offering up himself. For the Law appoints as priests men who are weak; but the word of the oath, which came after the Law, appoints a Son who is forever perfect. Now the main point in what we are saying is this: we have such a high priest who has taken his seat at the right hand of the throne of majesty in the heavens, a minister of the Holies and of the true tabernacle, which the Lord has set up, and not man.

Gospel (Lk 19:1-10): Zacchaeus' Repentance

At that time as Jesus was passing through Jericho, behold there was a man named Zacchaeus; and he was a leading publican, and he was rich. And he was trying to see Jesus, to find out who he was, but could not, on account of the crowd, because he was small of stature. So he ran on ahead and climbed up into a sycamore tree to see him, for he was going to pass that way. And when Jesus came to the place, he looked up and saw him, and said to him, "Zacchaeus, make haste and come down; for I must stay in your house today." And he made haste and came down, and welcomed him joyfully. And upon seeing it, all began to murmur, saying, "He has gone to be the guest of a man who is a sinner." But Zacchaeus stood and said to the Lord, "Behold, Lord, I give one-half of my possessions to the poor, and if I have defrauded anyone of anything, I restore it fourfold." Jesus said to him, "Today salvation has come to this house, since he, too, is the son of Abraham. For the Son of Man came to seek and to save what was lost."



A Scholarship: Thomas Aquinas College Summer High School Program Scholarship for their July 15 - 27, 2019 course at the Santa Paula campus, 70 miles north of Los Angeles. A full scholarship is available to youth entering going their senior High School year. This \$975 scholarship covers tuition, housing, meals, books, and organized off campus activities.

For two weeks, students from around the country and abroad will delight in spirited conversation, engaging some of the best works of the past 2,500 years, reading and discussing texts selected from the masters of the Western intellectual tradition. Martin Luther King Jr.

This past week we observed the birthday of the Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. For those of us from an orthodox tradition, we are edified when we recall that the former Greek Orthodox Archbishop of North and South America, Archbishop Iakovos, was one of a very few prominent non-African American clergymen, and the only leader of a major faith group, to walk hand in hand with King during the March in Selma -- a watershed event in U.S. Civil Rights history. Iakovos, in an interview following the march, noted that he was branded "un-American," "a traitor." Iakovos noted that he supported King because he, himself, as a non-Turk and non-Muslim in the Ottoman Empire, had been a third-class citizen; he knew, personally, what it was like to be denied basic civil and human rights. Let us remember when we recall Iakovos' bold action: our faith impels us to action in the cause of nurturing human life.


St. John Chrysostom القديس يوحنا الذهبي الفم

St. John Chrysostom (ca. 349 – 14 September 407), was Archbishop of Constantinople and was well known for his great preaching skills – hence his name, Chrysostom or “Golden Mouth” -- and his denunciations of abuse of power and authority. He is also the author of our Diving Liturgy celebrated today. He was also well known for his self-imposed and harsh asceticism. Due to some struggles with the “powers that be,” John was exiled from Constantinople and soon after died.

Later, in 438, his relics were transferred back to Constantinople – his earthly remains returned to his earthly home. On this day Holy Mother Church sings of her illustrious son:

Exult O Queen of all cities, as you receive today the relics of your good and chief shepherd, Chrysostom the mellifluous, whose guidance saved you and the whole world. Let our hands and mouths resound with music in his honor!

And: The holy and august Church is mystically gladdened today on the translation of your holy relics. And though she had kept them concealed like precious gold, through your intercessions she unceasingly grants them praise thee, the divine grace of healing, O Father John Chrysostom.
