And after He opened the volume, He found the place where it was written, "The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me; because He has anointed Me; to bring good news to the poor He has sent Me, to proclaim to the captives release, and sight to the blind; to set at liberty the oppressed, to proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord." And closing the volume, He gave it back to the attendant and sat down. And the eyes of all in the synagogue were upon Him. But He began to say to them, "Today this Scripture has been fulfilled in your hearing." And all bore Him witness, and marveled at the words of grace that came from His mouth.

# **Happy New Church Year!**

That's right, Happy New Year! Today, on September 1, we begin a new ecclesiastical (i.e., church) year. The custom of marking a new year on this date has ancient roots. The Jewish people, our forebears in faith, mark their new year in what is now our month of September.

During the days of the Roman Empire, all subjects were required to pay taxes. Since economic conditions change over time, there was a periodic reassessment of those taxes. Naturally, since a good portion of income came from agricultural resources, emperors waited until the harvests, for the most part, were complete at the end of the summer growing season and produce was stored for autumn and winter. Hence, this reassessment came in what we call the month September. And in Roman Egypt, the assessment actually came on the first day of their month that would correspond to our September.


Overall, in the Roman Empire, the beginning of the year was Augustus' birthday, what we now call September 23<sup>rd</sup>. Eventually, in the middle of the Fifth Century, A.D., the beginning of the year in the Byzantine Empire shifted to September 1<sup>st</sup>.

As you can see, a variety of forces conspired and, over time, the start of the ecclesiastical year came to rest on this day. And instead of singing "Auld Lang Syne" as we do on January 1<sup>st</sup>, we sing the troparia of the New Year: "Maker of the Universe, O Lord who alone have power over seasons and times: bless this year with Your bounty, preserve our country in safety and keep Your people in peace, through the prayers of the Mother of God, and save us."


