Reading from the Second Epistle of St. Paul to the Corinthians (4: 6-11)

Brethren, God who commanded light to shine out of darkness, has shone in our hearts, to give enlightenment concerning the knowledge of God's glory, shining in Christ Jesus' face. Upcoming feasts:

The Conception of St. John the Baptist: Forerunner of Our Lord, God, and Savior, Jesus Christ: 23 September. Fifteen months before the birth of the Messiah, the holy priest Zachariah and his holy wife Elizabeth, childless in their old age, finally had their prayers for a child answered. While Zachariah was fulfilling his sacred and priestly duties by offering sacrifice in the Temple, the Angel Gabriel came to him in a vision and delivered the Good News: "Your prayer is heard and Elizabeth shall bear a son, and he will be named John" (Luke 1:13). At first, Zachary did not believe this so he was struck



dumb by the angel. He remained mute until the birth of the Forerunner, whose coming had been prophesied by the Prophet Malachi. The Falling Asleep in the Lord of The Apostle and Evangelist John the Theologian: 26

September. As we know, John was from Bethsaida, Galilee, the son of Zebedee and Salome, and the brother of James the elder. A fisherman, he became an Apostle when called by Christ. Often presumed to be the Beloved Disciple, the dying Jesus on the Holy and Life-giving Cross entrusted John and the Theotokos to one another's care. John preached throughout Asia

Minor, mainly in Ephesus. Eventually exiled to the island of Patmos, where he is said of have been inspired to write the Book of Revelation. Later, returning to Ephesus, he wrote three universal Epistles and his Gospel, which expounds on the theology of the eternal Son and Word of God – winning for him the title "Theologian."


